Partnerships Strategy for Purposes

- Increasing international exchange collaborations by 3% in order to support international educational movement in order to make FMIPH a center of

- Establishing a joint center of excellence with national and international stakeholders in order to create a research environment aimed at excellence by ensuring the sustainability and development of the institutional structure in priority areas,
- interdisciplinary research ecosystem and encourage R&D studies so that pioneering research can be carried out worldwide in priority areas,
- sectoral relations and cooperation and increasing recognition among industrial organizations by facilitating the implementation of solutionoriented research activities in order to develop relations and collaborations with national and international stakeholders in priority areas,
- Developing relations and cooperation with national institutions and organizations by facilitating the implementation of multi- stakeholder research activities within the scope of national priorities, increasing recognition,
- Developing relations and cooperation by facilitating the implementation of research activities with international participation within the scope of global trends, increasing international recognition,
