Policy on Reducing Inequalities

Pursuant to Article 18 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, "No one can be deprived of the right according to his race". As required by this article of the Constitution, FMIPH attaches importance to its duty to provide equality of opportunity to everyone by doing its part to ensure the right of all members of the society to receive education without any discrimination. FMIPH policy towards reducing inequalities covers the following issues:

- It aims for individuals from all walks of society to receive education without discrimination.
- It provides equal education opportunities to all individuals from different parts of the society in all of its associate, undergraduate and graduate programs.
- opportunities are provided to underrepresented (and potentially underrepresented) groups, including ethnic minorities, low-income students and students with disabilities.
- It ensures the establishment of anti-discrimination and anti-harassment policies and their implementation by all units.
- It carries out scientific and social activities in order to establish antidiscrimination and anti-harassment policies.
- Plans the working and learning environment in the education process of disabled individuals.

 It creates social and physical facilitating and supporting structures for people with disabilities.

FMIPH carries out important studies in the context of providing equal opportunities in education and reducing inequalities. It will resolutely continue its efforts to defend each individual's right to education, which is also protected by the constitution. In the context of its works, it prioritizes sustainability in its works in order to ensure that all individuals receive education by reducing inequalities at both regional and national level in the coming years.
